Dear EDR Parents,

You are probably already aware that Macron announced this evening that all schools will be closed as of Monday, until further notice from the government. Given this new development, please note the following:

- The boarding staff have announced this to the students, and they are working together with the students and with you as parents to ensure a safe and organized return home for your children.
- The bus to Paris will be leaving tomorrow evening as per normal; however, **there will be no return bus on Sunday evening, and students who leave for the weekend should not plan on returning to school until the government announces that schools are allowed to reopen.**
- Students who need to take flights from Paris should, if possible, organize these for Saturday or Sunday. Students have been informed that we are organizing the airport departures as we would for a normal vacation departure.
- As mentioned in previous emails, we will maintain a reduced boarding service for all international students who are not able to travel home. Please do not panic; your children will be well looked-after!
- All students have been informed that they must be using their school email accounts and Ecole Directe, and we will be checking and helping students with this during the day tomorrow. The school will be doing everything possible to ensure the continuity of the courses, through both synchronous and asynchronous online activities.
- We will communicate to the students as soon as possible regarding any eventual changes, should there be any, to the organisation and dates for the IB, French Bac, Cambridge and FLE exams.

If you have questions regarding any of the above, please do not hesitate to ask. We will be in contact with you in the days to come with updates and further information. We look forward to welcoming back your children as soon as we are allowed to reopen our classes!
