**Goal :** to equip young people with the knowledge, understanding, attitudes and practical skills to live healthily, safely, productively and responsibly.

One hour every two weeks Mr Paul Bold is running lessons completely in English to each class of « Collège » parallelly to Civic & Moral Education class (these teachers are the history teachers) . As well as EMC, PSHE could be taught by different teachers from different subjects.
